**Guidelines:** The student presentation is worth 16% of the total course grade, but we will use a 60-point system because: (a) it makes it easier to grade using the six categories below, with 10 points being the maximum for each category, and (b) students who don't do the presentation will be doing Homeworks 2 and 4, and the grades for those will also sum to 60 points.

Thus, for each category below, 10 points corresponds to meeting all the criteria with no significant problems. 9 points corresponds to generally meeting the criteria, but with a minor problem that could have been handled better. 8 points or lower corresponds to clearly not meeting some aspect of the listed criteria.
